

PARVEZ (*1967, India)

COMMODI-FICTION

A six months long Live Art work; with Performances, Installations and Interventions. Each Performance / Installation / Action, while complete in itself, works as a chapter that keeps adding to, and unfolding, the narrative until the very end.

MUSEUM1, Adligenswil
April 10 to October 2, 2021

The show centers on Live / Performance Art works and Installations that create possibilities for encounters and participative interactions for the visitors. The exhibition narrative unfolds and evolves with each action until the very end.

‘COMMODI-FICTION’ stems from the concept of ‘fictitious commodities’ that the economic historian and thinker, Karl Polanyi conceived, vis-à-vis the commodification of land, human labor and currency, in his work ‘The Great Transformation: The Political and Economic Origins of Our Time’. The artist expands upon these ideas, plays with the workings of a market-based-economy and also explores its connection with (neo)colonialism – the continuation of colonial subjugation and exploitation through economic, political, cultural, and/or other tools.

MUSEUM1 - a museum without barriers, without a roof, without security personnel to guard the treasures or ward people off the ‘art works’, without tickets and without opening or closing hours – inspired the artist. The physical presence of an Art space without any protective boundaries offered a fresh perspective on the possibilities of inclusivity and the embeddedness of art within a society. While most art and cultural spaces were forced by the Covid-19 pandemic to close their doors last year, MUSEUM1 did not do so - because there were no doors to be closed. In July 2020, the curator, Stephan Wittmer, and the artist, Parvez met at M1, and the idea for the show was born.

PARVEZ is a multidisciplinary, conceptual artist from India (currently based in Basel). His work is mostly grounded in socio-political situations and (neo)colonial history. He engages with Live Art / Performance, Installation, Video, Image and Text among others and uses a variety of material ranging from the body and Images (moving and still) to found objects and industrial products.

He studied Medicine and worked in Psychiatry after graduating from a Medical school in India in 1990. His experiences as a medical professional played a major role in pushing him towards Media and Arts. In 1995, he left the hospital to pursue filmmaking and learnt the craft on the job. Over the years, he expanded his practice into conceptual art.
